

Museum Directions

From the East Building (Arthur M. Sackler Gallery) Garden Entrance



This accessible entrance features an automatic door and elevator access to all points of interest. There are no stairs at this entrance. Security screening occurs at all points of entry.

To the East Building Galleries and Museum Store

Turn left and walk toward the Moongate Café. Go through the stone archway on the left. Take the elevator on the right down to level B1 to access the galleries and museum store. Additional galleries can be accessed on levels B2 and B3 using the same elevator.

To the West Building (Freer Gallery of Art) Galleries 1–19

Turn left and walk toward the Moongate Café. Go through the stone archway on the left. Take the elevator on the right down to level B1 and exit the elevator vestibule. Turn right and enter gallery 21 on the left, which displays the exhibition *Feast Your Eyes*. Proceed through the exhibition and take the elevator beyond the staircase up to level ★G. Turn right out of the elevator and proceed down the long hallway. Turn left through the first archway. Turn right to go toward the elevator at the end of the hallway on the left. Take the elevator up to level 1. Access galleries 9–1 to the left and galleries 19–10 to the right. Two short flights of steps separate these two sets of galleries; backtrack to see those on the other side.

To the ImaginAsia Studio*

**Only open when programs are in session. Please see the information desk for details.*

Turn left and walk toward the Moongate Café. Go through the stone archway on the left. Take the elevator on the right down to level B2. Exit the elevator vestibule and go straight ahead. The ImaginAsia Studio is on the right. The entrance will require assistance. The Interactive Cosmic Buddha is on the left.

To the Meyer Auditorium*

**Only open when programs are in session. Please see the information desk for details.*

Turn left and walk through the Moongate Café. Go through the stone archway on the left. Take the elevator on the right down to level B1 and exit the elevator vestibule. Turn right and enter gallery 21 on the left, which displays the exhibition *Feast Your Eyes*. Proceed through the exhibition and take the elevator beyond the staircase up to level ★G. Turn right out of the elevator and proceed down the long hallway. Turn left through the first archway. The entrance to the Meyer Auditorium is on the left.

To the nearest restroom

Turn left and walk toward the Moongate Café. Go through the stone archway on the left. Take the elevator on the right down to level B1 and exit the elevator vestibule. To get to the women's room, turn left and proceed through the wood archway. To get to the men's room, turn right and proceed through the wood archway. There are more restrooms downstairs via the elevator on levels B2 and B3.

Museum Directions

From the West Building (Freer Gallery of Art) Entrance on Independence Avenue



This accessible entrance features an automatic door and elevator access to all points of interest. This entrance can also be accessed via stairs. Security screening occurs at all points of entry.

To the West Building Galleries

Take the elevator or stairs up to level 1. Access galleries 9–1 to the left and galleries 19–10 to the right. Two short flights of steps separate these two sets of galleries; for step-free access, backtrack to see those on the other side.

To Gallery 20

Take the elevator down to level G. Exit the elevator vestibule and proceed to the hallway behind the three stone arches. Continue down this long hallway, following the yellow East Building signs for galleries 21–30 and the museum store. On the left will be another elevator; take this up to level GR. Turn to the left and gallery 20 will be in front of you. Follow the gallery to the right to access the rest of gallery 20, which will be on the left.

To the East Building (Arthur M. Sackler Gallery) and the Museum Store

Take the elevator down to level G. Exit the elevator vestibule and proceed to the hallway behind the three stone arches. Continue down this long hallway to the right, following the yellow East Building signs for galleries 21–30 and the museum store. On the left will be another elevator; take this down to level B1. Exit the elevator vestibule to the left to enter the East Building via gallery 21, which displays the exhibition *Feast Your Eyes*. At the end of gallery 21, continue straight toward more galleries or turn to the right to find the museum store on the right. There are more galleries on levels B2 and B3, which can be accessed via the elevator across from the museum store.

To the ImaginAsia Studio*

**Only open when programs are in session. Please see the information desk for details.*

Take the elevator down to level G. Exit the elevator vestibule and proceed to the hallway behind the three stone arches. Continue down this long hallway, following the yellow East Building signs for galleries 21–30 and the museum store. On the left will be another elevator; take this to level B1. Exit the elevator vestibule to the left to enter the East Building via gallery 21, which displays the exhibition *Feast Your Eyes*. Proceed through the exhibition and turn right into the hallway at the end of gallery 21. On the left is another elevator; take this down to level B2. Exit the elevator vestibule and go straight. The ImaginAsia Studio is on the right. The entrance will require assistance. The Interactive Cosmic Buddha is on the left.

To the Meyer Auditorium

**Only open when programs are in session. Please see the information desk for details.*

Take the elevator down to level G. Exit the elevator vestibule and turn right. Proceed through the foyer to the Meyer Auditorium entrance.

To the nearest restroom

Take the elevator down to level G. Exit the elevator vestibule and proceed to the hallway behind the three stone arches. The men's restroom is to the left, and the women's restroom is to the right.

Museum Directions

From the West Building (Freer Gallery of Art) Entrance on the National Mall, Jefferson Drive



This entrance can only be accessed via stairs, and all points of interest are accessed by additional stairs. Accessible entry is available from Independence Ave. and the Enid A. Haupt Garden. Security screening occurs at all points of entry.

Proceed to one of these entrances by entering the garden on the left. To enter the East Building, continue straight and turn to the right at the parterre garden bed. The entrance to the East Building has automatic doors. Proceed using the East Building directions.

To enter the West Building, instead take the first right in the garden and then turn right. Enter the West Building via the bronze automatic doors and proceed using the Independence Avenue directions.
